MATTHEW'S VERSION OF THE OLIVET DISCOURSE (Matt 24:1-31)

24:1 Then Jesus went out and departed from the Temple, and His disciples came up to show Him the buildings of the Temple. ²And Jesus said to them, "Do you not see all these things? Assuredly, I say to you, not one stone shall be left here upon another, that shall not be thrown down." ³Now as He sat on the Mount of Olives, the disciples came to Him privately, saying, "Tell us, 1)When will these things be? And 2)What will be the sign of Your coming, and of the end of the age?"

EVENTS <u>BETWEEN</u> JERUSALEM'S FALL AND THE SECOND COMING (First 5 seals of Revelation 6) ⁴And Jesus answered and said to them: "Take heed that no one deceives you. 1)⁵For many will come in My name, saying, 'I am the Christ,' and will deceive many. ⁶And you will hear of 2)wars and rumors of wars. See that you are not troubled; for all these things must come to pass, but the end is not yet. ⁷For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom. And there will be 3)famines, 4)pestilences, and earthquakes in various places. ⁸All these are the beginning of sorrows.

5) 9"Then they will deliver you up to tribulation and kill you, and you will be hated by all nations for My name's sake. 10And then many will be offended, will betray one another, and will hate one another. 11Then many false prophets will rise up and deceive many. 12And because lawlessness will abound, the love of many will grow cold. 13But he who endures to the end shall be saved. 14And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in all the world as a witness to all the nations, and then the end will come.

JERUSALEM'S FALL ¹⁵"Therefore when you see the 'Abomination of Desolation,' spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing in the holy place" (whoever reads, let him understand), ¹⁶"then let those who are in Judea flee to the mountains. ¹⁷Let him who is on the housetop not go down to take anything out of his house. ¹⁸And let him who is in the field not go back to get his clothes. ¹⁹But woe to those who are pregnant and to those who are nursing babies in those days! ²⁰And pray that your flight may not be in winter or on the Sabbath. ²¹For then there will be GREAT TRIBULATION, such as has not been since the beginning of the world until this time, no, nor ever shall be. ²²And unless those days were shortened, no flesh would be saved; but for the elect's sake those days will be shortened.

²³"Then if anyone says to you, 'Look, here is the Christ!' or 'There!' do not believe it. ²⁴For false christs and false prophets will rise and show great signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, even the elect. ²⁵See, I have told you beforehand. ²⁶"Therefore if they say to you, 'Look, He is in the desert!' do not go out; or 'Look, He is in the inner rooms!' do not believe it. ²⁷For as the lightning comes from the east and flashes to the west, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be. ²⁸For wherever the carcass is, there the eagles will be gathered together.

THE SECOND COMING (Sixth seal of Revelation 6) ²⁹"Immediately AFTER THE TRIBULATION of those days the <u>sun</u> will be darkened, and the <u>moon</u> will not give its light; the <u>stars will fall from heaven</u>, and the <u>powers of the heavens will be shaken</u>. ³⁰Then the sign of the Son of Man will appear in heaven, and then all the tribes of the earth will mourn, and they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory. ³¹And He will send His angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they will gather together His elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.

MARK'S VERSION OF THE OLIVET DISCOURSE (Mark 13:1-27)

13:1 Then as He went out of the Temple, one of His disciples said to Him, "Teacher, see what manner of stones and what buildings are here!"

²And Jesus answered and said to him, "Do you see these great buildings? Not one stone shall be left upon another, that shall not be thrown down."

3Now as He sat on the Mount of Olives opposite the Temple, Peter, James, John, and Andrew asked Him privately, 4"Tell us, 1)When will these things be? And 2)What will be the sign when all these things will be fulfilled?"

EVENTS BETWEEN JERUSALEM'S FALL AND THE SECOND COMING (First 5 seals of Revelation 6) 5And Jesus, answering them, began to say: "Take heed that no one deceives you. 1)6For many will come in My name, saying, 'I am He,' and will deceive many. 7But when you hear of 2)wars and rumors of wars, do not be troubled; for such things must happen, but the end is not yet. 8For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against

kingdom. And there will be earthquakes in various places, and there will be 3)famines and

5) 9"But watch out for yourselves, for they will deliver you up to councils, and you will be beaten in the synagogues. You will be brought before rulers and kings for My sake, for a testimony to them. ¹⁰And the gospel must first be preached to all the nations. ¹¹But when they arrest you and deliver you up, do not worry beforehand, or premeditate what you will speak. But whatever is given you in that hour, speak that; for it is not you who speak, but the Holy Spirit. 12Now brother will betray brother to death, and a father his child; and children will rise up against parents and cause them to be put to death. ¹³And you will be hated by all for My name's sake. But he who endures to the end shall be saved.

JERUSALEM'S FALL 14"So when you see the 'Abomination of Desolation,' spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing where it ought not" (let the reader understand), "then let those who are in Judea flee to the mountains. 15Let him who is on the housetop not go down into the house, nor enter to take anything out of his house. ¹⁶And let him who is in the field not go back to get his clothes. ¹⁷But woe to those who are pregnant and to those who are nursing babies in those days! 18And pray that your flight may not be in winter. 19For IN THOSE DAYS THERE WILL BE TRIBULATION, such as has not been since the beginning of the creation which God created until this time, nor ever shall be. ²⁰And unless the Lord had shortened those days, no flesh would be saved; but for the elect's sake, whom He chose, He shortened the days.

²¹"Then if anyone says to you, 'Look, here is the Christ!' or, 'Look, He is there!' do not believe it. ²²For false christs and false prophets will rise and show signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, even the elect. ²³But take heed; see, I have told you all things beforehand.

THE SECOND COMING (Sixth seal of Revelation 6) 24"But in those days, AFTER THAT TRIBULATION, the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light; 25the stars of heaven will fall, and the powers in the heavens will be shaken. ²⁶Then they will see the Son of Man coming in the clouds with great power and glory. ²⁷And then He will send His angels, and gather together His elect from the four winds, from the farthest part of earth to the farthest part of heaven.

LUKE'S VERSION OF THE OLIVET DISCOURSE (Luke 21:1-28)

21:5 Then as some spoke of the Temple, how it was adorned with beautiful stones and donations, He said, 6"These things which you see—the days will come in which not one stone shall be left upon another that shall not be thrown down."

⁷So they asked Him, saying, "Teacher, but 1)When will these things be? And 2)What sign will there be when these things are about to take place?"

EVENTS BETWEEN JERUSALEM'S FALL AND THE SECOND COMING (First 5

seals of Revelation 6) ⁸And He said: "Take heed that you not be deceived. 1)For many will come in My name, saying, 'I am He,' and, 'The time has drawn near.' Therefore do not go after them. ⁹But when you hear of 2)wars and commotions, do not be terrified; for these things must come to pass first. But the end will not come immediately."

¹⁰Then He said to them, "Nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom. ¹¹And there will be great earthquakes in various places, and 3)famines and 4)pestilences; and there will be fearful sights and great signs from heaven. ¹²But before all these things, 5)they will lay their hands on you and persecute you, delivering you up to the synagogues and prisons. You will be brought before kings and rulers for My name's sake. ¹³But it will turn out for you as an occasion for testimony. ¹⁴Therefore settle it in your hearts not to meditate beforehand on what you will answer. ¹⁵For I will give you a mouth and wisdom which all your adversaries will not be able to contradict or resist. ¹⁶You will be betrayed even by parents and brothers, relatives and friends; and they will put some of you to death. ¹⁷And you will be hated by all for My name's sake. ¹⁸But not a hair of your head shall be lost. ¹⁹By your patience possess your souls.

JERUSALEM'S FALL ²⁰"But when you see Jerusalem surrounded by armies, then know that its desolation is near. ²¹Then let those who are in Judea flee to the mountains, let those who are in the midst of her depart, and let not those who are in the country enter her. ²²For these are the days of vengeance, that all things which are written may be fulfilled. ²³But woe to those who are pregnant and to those who are nursing babies in those days! For there will be great distress in the land and wrath upon this people. ²⁴And they will fall by the edge of the sword, and be led away captive into all nations. And Jerusalem will be trampled by Gentiles until the times of the Gentiles are fulfilled.

THE SECOND COMING (Sixth seal of Revelation 6) ²⁵"And there will be signs in the <u>sun</u>, in the <u>moon</u>, and in the <u>stars</u>. And on the earth distress of nations, with perplexity; the sea and the waves roaring. ²⁶Men's hearts failing them from fear and the expectation of those things which are coming on the earth. For <u>the powers of the heavens will be shaken</u>. ²⁷Then they will see the Son of Man coming in a cloud with power and great glory. ²⁸Now when these things begin to happen, look up and lift up your heads, because your redemption draws near."
